Beverley Sheehan and The Creole Bells

This will be something very special presented by Jazz Australia in association with St. Andrew's Music Foundation. It seemed a long way off when I first announced this wonderful collaboration between the Creole Bells Revival Band and one of our most popular Melbourne jazz vocalists Beverley Sheehan, and now all of a sudden it is Spring and *just around the corner!*

Traditional jazz evolved from spiritual and gospel music, which originated from church music and the heartfelt gospel songs sung by the American slaves in the deep south of America, singing to ease their oppression. 'The words of these songs are so heartfelt and uplifting that they are a joy to perform' says Beverley Sheehan referring to the program on October 16th. 'We are going to bring all this music to you in a happy and *inspiriting* afternoon, combining two styles of music – Jazz and Gospel. We will include gospel songs from the 'Empress of the Blues' Bessie Smith and also Sister Rosetta Tharpe, Ma Rainey and Mahalia Jackson to name a few.'

St. Andrews Church, with its beautiful sanctuary, will be perfect for this uplifting concert.

Steve Waddell says 'There is *nothing* quite like a cathedral or Church to enhance the pleasure of listening and performing music. The Creole Bells Revival Band has played gospel services in many churches over the years and the purity of sound is always such a wonderful experience. Hot from an inspiring recent salute to the great Louis Armstrong, we will be presenting music of several of the legendary vocalists with whom he recorded.'

OTHER JAZZ NEWS: JAZZ AUSTRALIA CRUISE

On June 5th 2017 I am leading a contingent of *no more* than 100 people, on what I know will be a superb Jazz Cruise for 12 days to the South Pacific, on the Sun Princess. We will be accompanied by the great interstate jazz band *STATE SUMMIT* which consists of three Sydney musicians, leader and trumpet player Bob Henderson, clarinetist Paul Furniss [both in Graeme Bell's band for 20 years] and jazz vocalist Helen Fenton; plus Melbourne musicians Chris Ludowyk, bass and trombone; Ian Smith, drums and vocals, and Steve Grant, piano [if he's not overseas, in which case I have another great pianist in mind from Sydney]. The Jazz component of this cruise is already over half booked and I expect we will be fully booked within the next month or so. Jazz Australia delegates will have ten exclusive concerts with *State Summit* during this twelve day cruise, each *with a difference*. I will arrange session times around excursions and other entertainment on board, so that Jazz Australia delegates will have the best of both worlds!
